## **Buffer Planting Recommended Plant Palette**

### ***Buffer Planting Specifications:***

Landscape Buffer requirements: Landscape plants must be maintained at least thirty-six to forty-six inches (36” – 48”) in height to provide one hundred percent (100%) coverage of buffered area. Plant material will be planted in a “double staggered row” spaced thirty-six to forty-six inches (36”- 48”) O.C (On Center) with a recommended tree. Quantities and sizes of trees will vary on buffer length.
